The 2007 Cancer Reform Strategy established the National Cancer Intelligence Network (NCIN) in order to bring together all stakeholders involved in the collection, processing, analysis and interpretation of cancer data to bring about a quantum change in the information available to support the delivery of quality cancer services. The ambition is to create the best cancer information system in the world by 2012.
